




## HOCUS POCUS 2

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# PLANNING FOR YOUR FUTURE!

## What is an Advanced Directive?

An advanced directive is a written statement which reliably shows that you have made your health care decisions known or have appointed another person to make those decision on your behalf. An Advance Directive may be called a “Living Will” or “Power of Attorney for Health Care” However, an Advance Directive may be called other things.

## What is a Living Will?

A Living Will generally states the kind of medical care you want or do not want if you are unable to verbalize your wishes. For example, if you are taken to a hospital in a coma. It is called a Living Will because it takes effect while you are still living. A Living Will must be signed and notarized. A Living Will should clearly states your wishes regarding your health care.

## What is a Power of Attorney for Health Care?

A Power of Attorney for Health Care is a legal paper naming another person to make medical decisions for you should you become unable to make them for yourself, this person should be guided by your instructions as to what you want or do not want. A Power of Attorney for Health Care must be in writing and specifically authorize an “agent” to make health care decision on your behalf if you are unable. This too will need to be notarized.


## What is a “Five Wishes”?

Five Wishes document gives you a way to control how you are treated if you are seriously ill. It is an easy to complete form that lets you say exactly what you want. Once it is filled out and properly signed it is valid under the laws of most states. This can protect your loved ones from having to make hard choices for on your behalf. You get to say what is important to you.

## FYI

- ⊞ If you have questions, you may talk with family or friends you trust, your doctor, your attorney, or others who could help you understand your choices.
- ⊞ Make sure your health care provider and your agent have a copy of your paper work.
- ⊞ You can change or cancel your advance directive at any time, just remember to give your health care professional a new copy for your records.
- ⊞ Your Advanced Directive only takes effect after you are no longer able to make your own personal decisions.
