

Water Loss from a Leaking Faucet



30 Drips per Minute

129.6 Gallons per Month

17.3 Cubic Feet per Month

60 Drips per Minute

259.2 Gallons per Month

34.7 Cubic Feet per Month

120 Drips per Minute

518.4 Gallons per Month

69.3 Cubic Feet per Month

Small continuous faucet leaks will waste large amounts of water. In addition, leaks in hot-water lines will waste heat. Keep all valves and faucets tight. When a leak develops, replace faucet washers. If valves or faucets are damaged, replace faucet valve assembly.

Water Loss from a Leaking Toilet



Leaking toilets can waste up to an estimated:

.5 gallon (.07 cubic feet) per minute.

30 gallons (4 cubic feet) per hour.

720 gallons (96 cubic feet) per day.

21,600 gallons (2,887 cubic feet) per month.
